

HUMBOLDT COUNTY 4-H **ALL STAR APPLICATION**

The All Star is the highest 4-H Youth Development honor attainable at the County level. All Stars serve as county ambassadors for the 4-H program and give support to the 4-H clubs and county events. It is a working honor.

An All Star needs to exhibit the following qualities:

1. Demonstrate leadership ability, citizenship concern, and maturity of judgment.
2. Have a strong interest in continuing in 4-H programs for at least one additional year.
3. Present specific ideas on ways to give guidance and leadership to some area of 4-H Youth Development.
4. Make a commitment to expand the social and cultural boundaries of the County 4-H Youth Development Program.
5. Cooperate with fellow All Stars and Interns for the growth and development of 4-H within the County.
6. Recognize the opportunities and responsibilities of being selected a 4-H All Star and serve as an excellent role model for younger members.
7. Function as a public relations agent for 4-H.

All Stars are encouraged to attend the WHY Conference, the State Leadership Conference and other Leadership and Citizenship conferences.

Qualifications

To be eligible as an All Star, a 4-H member must:

- 1) be at least a sophomore in high school
- 2) have completed at least one year in 4-H
- 3) be currently enrolled in good standing in 4-H

Gold Star awards and the All Star Intern position are not prerequisites for the All Star.

Application Process

1. Complete the All Star resume.
2. Write a 4-H essay, 300-500 words in length, typed, double-spaced, which strongly relates your leadership skills and potential, concern for the community and others around you, and your ability to make good, sound judgments. You may include 4-H, educational, employment, community and social group experiences.
3. Read and sign the All Star Contract.
4. Submit two references on the All Star Reference Form, one of which must be a 4-H leader (non-relative).
5. All documents ***must*** be received in the County 4-H Office by the set deadline in order to be considered for an All Star interview.
6. Appear for an interview with the County 4-H All Star Selection Committee on the specified date and time.
7. The recommendations and decisions of the Humboldt County All Star Selection Committee are final.
